#### **Sacred Heart Cemetery Update**

Over the last 2 ½ years, all the data regarding plots in the Sacred Heart Cemetery have been entered into a computerized management system entitled Cemetery Information Management System (CIMS). There are currently over 1100 plots that have been included. In reviewing cemetery records and doing field checks, it was clear the data was incomplete and that multiple inaccuracies existed. An effort is underway to obtain additional data and correct those inaccuracies. This can only be done if plot owners are willing to assist. It will be beneficial to undertake this effort now and not wait until a family burial is imminent. 
