The Sacrament of Anointing the Sick

This Sacrament is NOT just for the dying. The Sacrament can be received more than once over the course of an illness. The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given to those who are seriously ill by anointing them on the forehead and hands with duly blessed oil with the words: **"Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up."** (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1513). After first and second verse of this special prayer the Penitent answers: **Amen.**
