HAPPY Mother's Day

Today we celebrate **Mother's Day** and yet many of us may not be aware that the first Mother's Day was proclaimed on May 9, 1914 through the efforts of Anna Jarvis of Philadelphia who wanted to remember her mother and all mothers. Anna's mother had been very active in working to improve the health of people and she convinced her mother's church to celebrate Mother's Day on the anniversary of her mother's death.

While Mother's Day in the United States is a secular holiday, the Catholic Church has celebrated the original "Mothering Sunday" since the earliest years of the Church on Laetare Sunday, the fourth Sunday in the liturgical season of Lent. On this day, people would pay a visit and return to their mother church where they were baptized, otherwise their local parish church or the nearest cathedral (the mother church to all churches in the diocese.) Those that returned to their mother church on Mothering Sunday were said to have gone "a-mothering."

On this special Day to honor Mothers, we thank God for Motherhood's wonder, miracle, and gift. Mothers carry us in their wombs, the first home of the whole human race. They offer us to the family, the Church, and the whole world. Mothers gave us life and birthed us into the relationships which give our life meaning, the family. They taught and nurtured us on the way by offering wisdom, giving us love, and making sacrifices. Mothers picked us up when we fell and unconditionally loved us back when we strayed. There is no one like a mother, no substitute for her place, no equal to her love and placement in our life. St. Therese of Lisieux said: "The loveliest masterpiece of the heart of God is the heart of a mother."

Lots of other countries celebrate Mother's Day at different times of the year as well.

We also honor our Blessed Mother today Who received a beautiful crown last Sunday. Let us turn to our Mother Mary and pray for our living and deceased mothers.
