Lenten Rules *Fasting & Abstinence*

Catholics ages 18 to 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Consumption of one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to a full meal is permitted. However, snacking between meals is not. Those aged 14 + are required to abstain (no meat or poultry) from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

The three hands symbolize the saint's generosity and purity. The phrase "when you give to someone in need, don't let your left hand know what your right hand is doing" is from the Bible, Matthew 6:3. There are more than 50 churches named after Casimir in Lithuania and Poland.
